



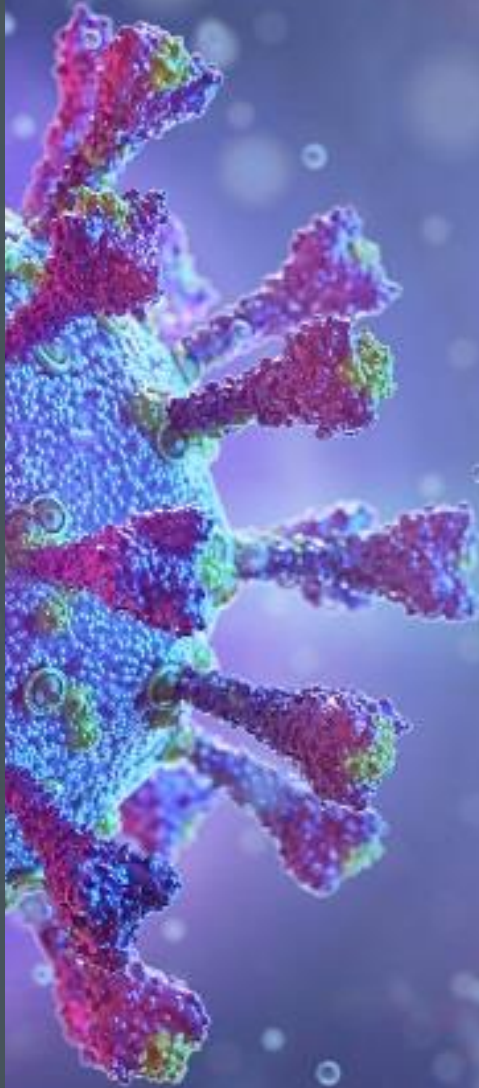

## IBN COVID-19 GLOBAL UPDATE JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup> 2020 - CALIFORNIA, USA

*State of California:* Governor Newsom announced that counties approved for accelerated reopening can begin to reopen hair salons and barbershops. Statewide, retailers and places of worship can reopen with modifications.

The California Insurance Commissioner Ricardo Lara issued a Notice requesting all insurance companies to provide policyholders with a grace period of at least 60 days to pay insurance premiums. The March 18 Notice was directed to all admitted and non-admitted insurance companies that provide any insurance coverage in California including, life, health, auto, property, casualty, and other types of insurance. As many state and local government “stay-at-home” orders have been extended through May, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to substantially impact the public’s ability to carry on its normal business. Accordingly, commissioner Lara is now requesting that all insurance companies provide their policyholders with an additional grace period to pay premiums.
